- Primary Readers are in the works catalogues coming soon for teachers to review
- Kindness Program organized by Beaches Women with a dog coming to each class for 25min about being kind to animals and lessons on how to approach animals - Program is Free All classes should be visited by end of Dec
- Roots of Empathy funding has been cut. Each session is now \$500 per class It has become too expensive for the school budget. Megan suggested Parent Council funding still very expensive. Beaches is doing 'baby visits' in lieu of Roots of Empathy. Suggestion to tie the program to a specific grade there also needs to be a trainer in the school. Do the teachers want to do the program? Teachers need to be open to the visits.

Other Business

- Healthy Families Night: Speakers are booked 5:45-7:45. Supper until 6:20 Vegetarian
 Option available. Food will be served in the gym too tight in the lobby. Centre 55 has agreed
 to plan activities, bring crafts etc and set up in the gym from 6:30-7:45. Megan Suggested to
 make a donation to Centre 55 split 1/3 (Beaches) and 2/3 (Kimberley) of \$500. Vote to donate
 \$340 to Centre 55 prior to Christmas was approved by council. Food will be provided by The
 Lunch Mom cost of food direct to families \$20/family or \$5 each. Request for help
 (volunteers) for Healthy Families Night will go out soon
- Chess program: Mixed reviews from teachers for chess program proposal (Grades 2-6) \$400
 8 sessions is a lot of classes taking away from curriculum. EQAO in May is a concern for some. Megan to ask teachers again if they would consider fewer sessions
 Lunch Program doesn't have as much success due to behaviour issues with no teacher present

Previously, parents signed up and paid \$100 for kids to join lunch program - became too much work for Principal (used to have 25 students signed up) . Suggestion for 1-2 teachers to take on the program and supervise. Parent Council will pay and/or parents could donate a nominal fee. Students to sign code of conduct and be removed from program if they're no cooperating Ms Rakel volunteered to help

Megan to double check with chess program if they're willing to do a lunch program
