Budget Update:

- Jessica to be new treasurer Jenn P will review everything with new Treasurer.
- New rules on fundraising by Nov 1, including cash online only and direct deposit Megan to send.
- No Family Fun Fair or PNO still on hook for bouncy castles for 2019 FF, but may have to pay it out this year without any payment. New council can ask Dar for info
- Separate budget meeting forthcoming.

Principal's Report:

- Entry protocol: classes are spaced out, screening completed outside and then hand sanitizer once they enter the classroom
- In rain, Gr 1-6 will enter through door 4. Kindergarten will enter through door 5. Socially distant the classes in hallways with supervision.
- Field divided into 11 zones for each classroom, and rotate each day. Kids are doing an amazing job staying in their zones, and enjoying the rotation. They have been great at

- finding things to do without equipment. Indoor recess they will be divided inside in different areas. Kindergarten will stay in their classrooms
- Outdoor learning is happening for gym, media, music plan to continue for the winter.
 Newsletter has mentioned to dress kids appropriately for winter
- Idea to add tree stumps to the yard to have more outdoor seating so snow pants don't get too wet.
- Mr McLeod has 120 yoga mats, just need to pay for shipping cost.
- Suggestion to work with Brad Bradford and urban forestry to deliver tree stumps Brendan to follow up. Come up with how many are required.
- Water bottle filling station still waiting disposable water bottles have been purchased/ donated in the meantime. Hoping to have filling machine installed soon.
- Received 17 new Chrome books last week. Technology can not be shared among students, so it is still not enough to use for a junior class. Students are allowed to bring devices to use at school
- Most teachers have connected with Google Classroom or BrightSpace currently used to connect with parents about homework and back up as virtual.
- Still no volunteers allowed in the school, so snack program is not running. If someone wants to come up with a proposal for snack program without parents in the school, please let Ruweida know. Megan is interested in putting together a plan.
- Do we need school council insurance? It may not be needed if there are not volunteers in the school. Maybe best to hold off on paying for insurance until it's needed.
- School Statement of Needs Megan will meet with Patti and Martine to go over binder and help update. Will need to add 'pandemic protocol'. Typically due end of Oct
- Still in process of hiring a .5 for Kindergarten prep currently a supply teacher in that position
- Today was deadline for re-organization and no new news
- Council Meeting dates for the rest of this year last Monday of each month except Dec and June. Council voted in favour
