- Kimberley J. P.S is a priority school re water filling station, no current status on when the station will be installed
- For now, the school will continue to keep disposable bottles of water on hand for students (donations are welcome)
- No snack program for the time being
- Principal Hassan-Bismilla has requested Kimberley J P.S be on the list for more outdoor seating
- Previous idea re tree stump, the board has requested not to proceed with donation regarding this as it could lead to liability issues for the school board
- Any outdoor alterative seating must be purchased though TDSB preferred suppliers
- Yoga mat shipping cost (council will cover up to 70% of shipping cost)
